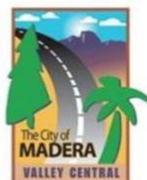
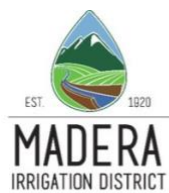
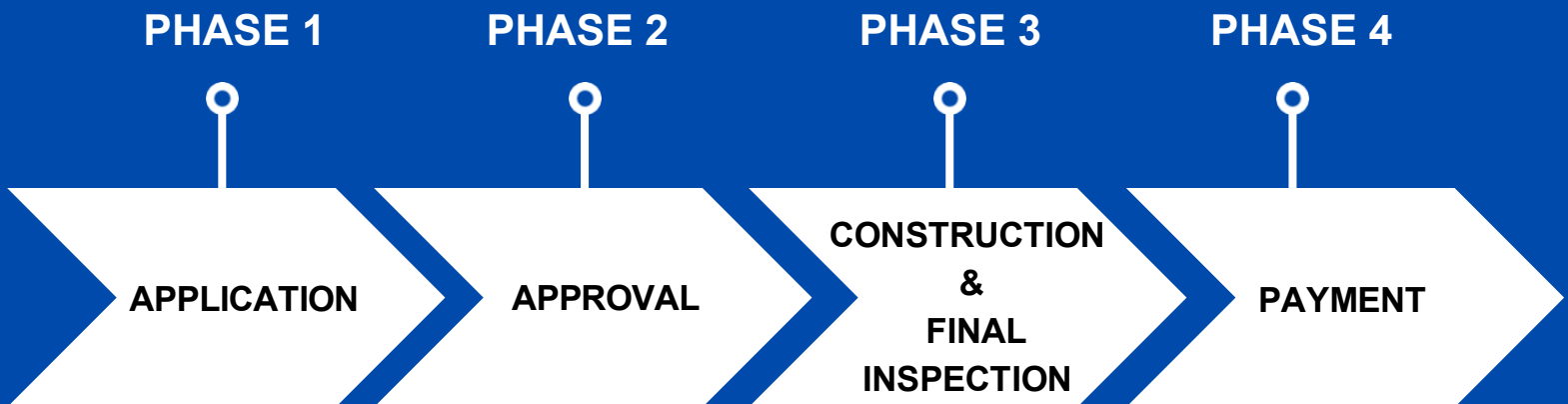
DOMESTIC WELL MITIGATION PROGRAM (DWMP)

This DWMP is for landowners within the boundaries of the Madera Irrigation District Groundwater Sustainability Agency (MID GSA), the City of Madera Groundwater Sustainability Agency (COM GSA), and the Madera Water District Groundwater Sustainability Agency (MWD GSA) only.

The program is to mitigate domestic wells that have gone dry due to declining water levels. Participants must be the landowner of record on the deed of the property. Renters are encouraged to contact the landowner if they would like to participate, applications will only be accepted from the landowner.

The DWMP will directly pay the well driller up to \$35,000 for the drilling of a new well ONLY.

PARTICIPATION IN THE DOMESTIC WELL MITIGATION PROGRAM OCCURS IN 4 PHASES:

PHASE 1 - APPLICATION

- Complete an Initial Well Assessment Form using a driller on the “Pre-Approved Driller List”
- Submit a completed application and all required documents
- Pay \$100 non-refundable application fee and schedule a site visit

PHASE 2 - APPROVAL

- Approval will be provided by DWMP Administrator on the Landowner Approval Process Form
- Once approved contact a well driller on the “Pre-Approved Driller List”
- Driller must sign the Landowner Approval Process Form prior to beginning work

PHASE 3 - CONSTRUCTION & FINAL INSPECTION

- When the well is complete, the driller will provide all required “Well Driller Documents”
- Landowner will contact DWMP Administrator for final inspection within 15 days of completion
- Failure to provide documentation and schedule final inspection within timeframe could result in loss of the approved amount and removal from the DWMP

PHASE 4 - PAYMENT

- The DWMP will directly pay the well driller up to \$35,000 for the drilling of a new well ONLY
- All additional costs above that amount or in addition to the drilling itself will be the sole responsibility of the landowner
- The well must be completed and all paperwork received by the DWMP Administrator within 195 days of approval or approval will expire
